### What Being a Child of God means

**Galatians 4:4-7** <sup>4</sup> But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, <sup>5</sup> to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. <sup>6</sup> Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father." <sup>7</sup> So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.

When we accept Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior, we become the sons of God (John1:12). We are



adopted into God's family. I want to talk about three aspects of our being children of God.

*First, all of our sins / debts (past, present, and future) are covered.* As sinners we have accumulated a staggering debt. This debt is far beyond what we can pay. If we have to pay for it, we will be eternally separated from God. But, praise be to the Lord! We do not have to pay for it, Christ did! God himself assumes accountability for our debt.

*Second, all of our future blessings are assured.* Two things happen to an adopted child. The child becomes the responsibility of that new family, and the child becomes an heir of that new family. The same thing happens to Christians. We become the responsibility of God. Our nurture and growth become his concern. God himself takes a personal interest in our spiritual growth and development. Sometimes this takes the form of incredible spiritual highs and sometimes it takes the form of spiritual

discipline, but it always takes the form of simple obedience to God's Word in our daily lives.

We also become heirs of our new family. This takes the form of blessings and God has told us that he has blessed us with every spiritual blessing. Ephesians 1:3: "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ." Furthermore, all of our blessings are assured. 1 Peter 1:3-5: "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In His great mercy He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, <sup>4</sup> and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade-- kept in heaven for you, <sup>5</sup> who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time."

*Third, all of our responsibilities are changed. We are now expected to live up to our new family standards. These involve chores, conduct, manners, etc. Alexander the Great said to a sloppy soldier also named Alexander, "Change your ways or change your name!"*

And certain things are expected of God's children. We assume the obligations of our new family. These obligations include: attending family gatherings (Worship Services on Sunday), sharing the Gospel, and reading and studying the Word of God.

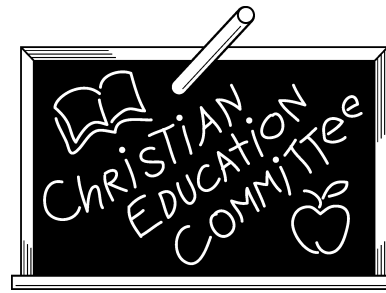
Having said this, please take some time to meditate upon these wonderful truths of your Christian Faith. This summer, please develop a plan to 1) read your Bible daily; 2) pray daily; 3) faithfully attend Worship each Sunday; 4) participate in a ministry of the church (Children's Sunday school, VBS, Grace Fest, Feed the Homeless, Oyster Festival, etc).

Folks, we have a wonderful church, a strong church for Jesus Christ, a vibrant church for Jesus Christ. Think and pray about how you can make us even better for our Lord Jesus Christ!

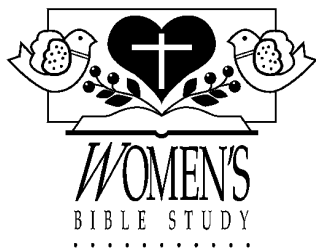


## *GBC Deaconess News*

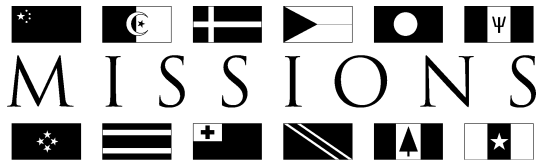

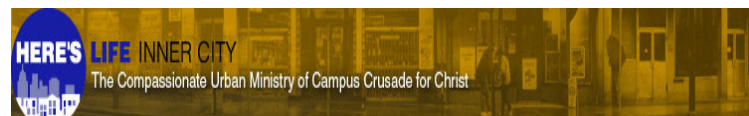

**What are S.A.Y. Yes! Centers for Youth Development?** S.A.Y. Yes! is a biblically-based program that is designed to minister to the physical, spiritual, emotional, social and intellectual needs of at-risk children and youth

in an after-school setting. The goal is to give them a solid foundation from which they can build a successful future.

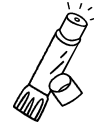
